## Where is the Safest Place?

**STATISTICS DON'T LIE! How to stay safe in the World today.**  
 Where IS the Safest Place?

1. **Avoid riding in automobiles** because they are responsible for 20% of all fatal accidents. 
2. **Do not stay home** because 17% of all accidents occur in the home. 
3. **Avoid walking on streets or sidewalks** because 14% of all accidents occur to pedestrians.

**Travelers:** Terri Nichols is still traveling. Several are returning today after spending the holidays with family.

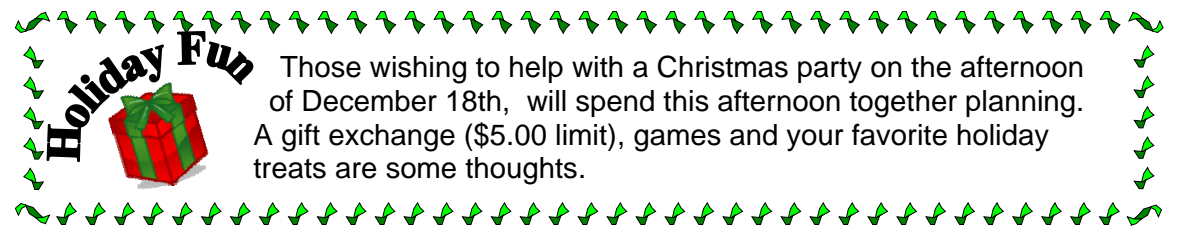
**Puppeteer Meeting:** A meeting will be held after Wednesday evening services on November 30.
