Book of 2 Chronicles

The book of 2 Chronicles begins with the construction of Solomon's Temple and concludes with Cyrus's edict to rebuild the Temple more than four hundred years later. In between, 2 Chronicles is the story of fading glory—the downward spiral of the kingdom of Judah in spite of the energetic efforts of a handful of reformers. The Temple and Temple worship remain central throughout the book, although the people stray far from it and ultimately pay the price for their waywardness.
