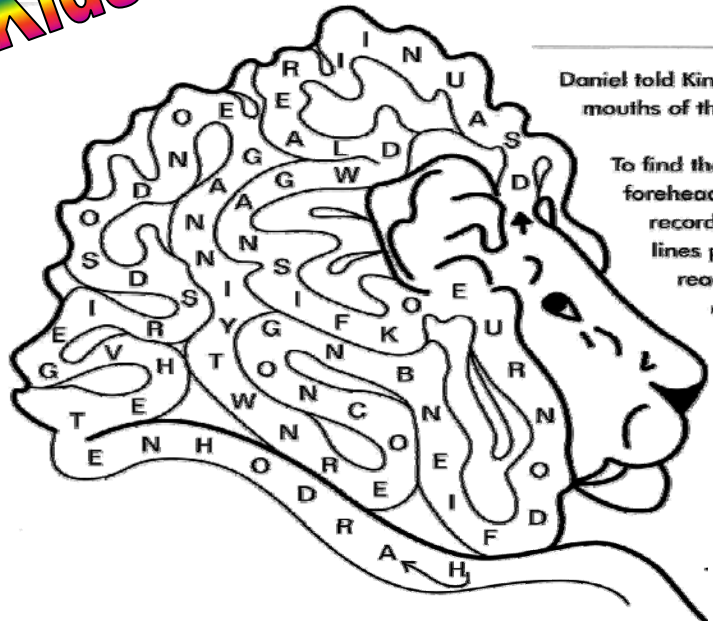

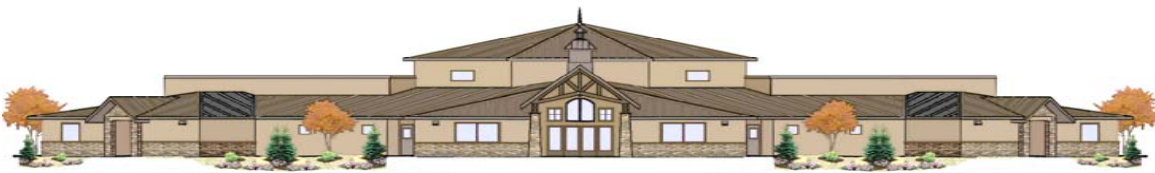

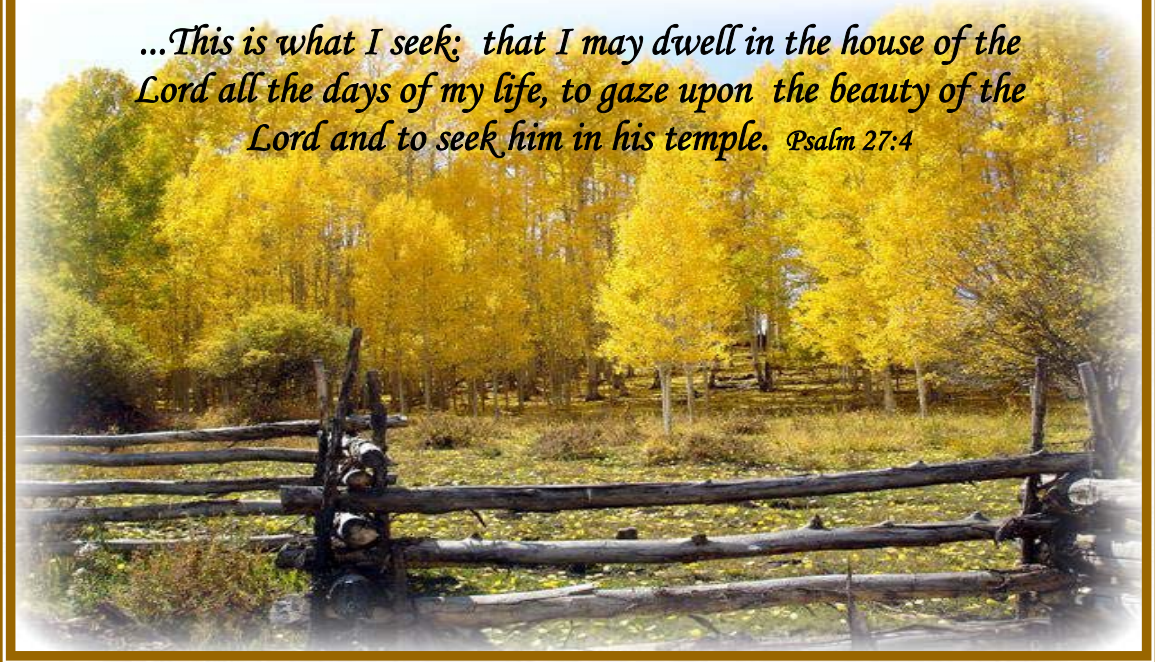
*Worthy To Be Adored*

## Book of Ezra

With the Temple rebuilt, a second group returns under Ezra the priest, this time to renew the spiritual vitality of the nation (Ezra 7-10). Between those two homecomings you'll find a fifty-eight-year interlude, during which the book of Esther takes place.
